Our Upper School Community



There are many reasons why the Head-Royce Upper School is such a stimulating place—the rigorous yet riveting course work, the incredible extracurriculars, the leadership, travel, and service opportunities and, best of all, the independence and trust conferred by the faculty.

In addition to their requirements in English, math, history, science, and world language (French, Spanish, Latin, or Mandarin), students have the flexibility and freedom to engage in a wide selection of engaging classes and advanced coursework—from Neurobiology to Engineering, and everything in between. Students also enjoy ample opportunities to get involved in the arts through school musicals and dramatic productions, orchestra, jazz band, dance, chorus, and our select vocal group, Colla Voce, as well as photography, graphic design, and ongoing studio art exhibits.



In our premier Upper School athletic program, students can play on 25 interscholastic teams, including baseball, basketball, cross country, golf, lacrosse, soccer, swimming, tennis, track and field, and volleyball. Our competitive programs have captured 36 league championships in the last five years and 125 since 2000.

Every year, Head-Royce has graduates that continue their athletic careers in college. Recent grads have competed at Brown, Colby, Emory, Georgetown, Howard, MIT, Occidental, Princeton, Stanford, Tufts, UC Berkeley, UCLA, University of Chicago, and Williams.
